NM 76 Area Sewer Improvements

Sealed bids will be received at the Espanola City Hall 405 North Paseo de Oñate, Española, NM 87532 for the project described below no later than 2:00 pm local time, April 7, 2022. The public opening and reading of bids will commence shortly after close of bid time at this location. Delivery of bids to the City of Espanola is the sole responsibility of the Bidders.

It is the Contractor's responsibility to obtain all amendments/addenda from the website prior to the bid opening.

Potential Bidders are required to fill out and submit the project-specific Acknowledgement of Receipt Form and return via email to the engineer of record to receive further communications including amendments/addenda to the bid documents. Please follow the return instructions on each project-specific Acknowledgement of Receipt Form. It is the Contractor's responsibility to obtain all amendments/addenda from the website prior to the bid opening.

**Description of Project:** Project consists of approximately 3610 lineal feet of 12" and 8" sewer line, with 24 manholes and 38 sewer service lines. Contractor to install Owner furnished materials as summarized in the table below. All other materials shall be furnished by the Contractor. The sewer line begins at the intersection of NM 76 and S. Mc Curry Rd and connects to an existing manhole. The sewer line then follows the eastbound lane of NM 76 for approximately 2473 lineal feet, then switches to the westbound lane (at the intersection of NM 106) for the remainder of the project. Project includes all related appurtenances in accordance with the Contract Documents.
