Those voters who have requested an absentee ballot for the 2022 Primary Election will be mailed a ballot on Tuesday, May 10, 2022. Voters may submit an absentee ballot application until Thursday, June 2, 2022. Upon receiving and completing the ballot, the voter shall mail the ballot with the prepaid return envelope to the Bernalillo County Clerk's Office, which will be notated on the return envelope.

Bernalillo County voters may also deliver the absentee ballot in person Monday-Friday beginning, May 10, 2022, through June 4, 2022, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. to the Bernalillo County Clerk's Office which is located at 415 Silver Ave N.W., Albuquerque, NM 87102. In addition, voters can deliver a ballot in person at the Clerk's Office Annex located at 1500 Lomas Blvd. NW, Suite A, Albuquerque, NM 87104.

During Early Voting and Election Day, a voter can deliver an absentee ballot to any Voting Convenience Center listed below. Ballots will be accepted until 7 p.m. on Election Day, Tuesday, June 7, 2022.
